5L:Esther, For showing a sensible and mature attitude towards learning. You can be counted on to make good choices! Well done!

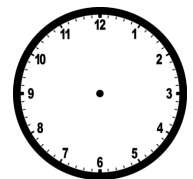
6J: Maison: For having such a positive attitude towards learning this year and really trying your best.
