Subject	In Year 6 we will be exploring...
Science 	Living things and their habitats (Spring 1) and Animals including humans (Spring 2), thinking about food chains and classifying living things.
Art & DT 	A sense of place - looking at the work of different artists and creating various pieces of Art linked to our Humanities topic. In DT, we will be making our own Chinese slippers, using various materials linked to our Ancient China topic.
Computing 	Online safety and the Book Creator app on iPads in order to create a book on the Shang Dynasty and then moving onto looking at coding for web design.
Humanities 	Understanding geographical similarities and differences through the study of human and physical geography of a region within North or South America. In History we will be looking at the Shang Dynasty of China.
PE 	Invasion games, gymnastics and circuit training.
R.E 	Islam and looking at various religious buildings and their importance.
PSHE 	Philosophical enquiry questions and looking at our dreams and goals (Spring 1) and then reasons why it's good to be them.
Music 	How to develop our musical skills through writing our own lyrics.
