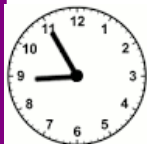

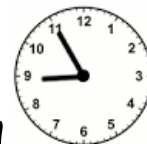

WATER DURING LESSONS

We encourage children to bring a bottle of water to school each day so that they can have access to it during lesson time, which has been shown to improve children's concentration.
