Term dates for 2018-2019 are now on the school website. Please make sure you check date before booking any holidays



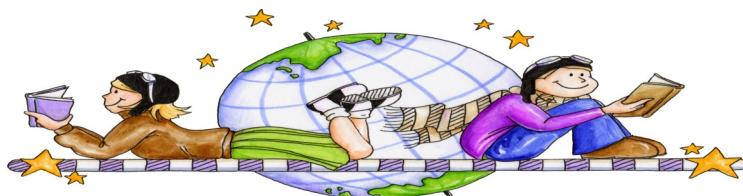
