Children must wear black school shoes. Trainers of any kind are not permitted and children will be asked to change.



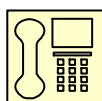
PE Kits

WATER DURING LESSONS

We currently encourage our children to bring a bottle of water to school each day so that they can have access to it during lesson time, which has been shown to improve children's concentration. We strongly recommend children do not bring bottled flavoured water as this has a sugar content of over 4grams, which can have a serious impact on children's teeth and general health when drunk over a period of time.
