Every day, children need to log into their email accounts and complete tasks emailed by their teachers. Please support them with this.

They need to go to londonmail.lgfl.net and log in using their LGFL login.

- a page with basic facts about the country (e.g. continent, capital city, population, currency, language, flag, etc)
- a page on food
- a page on landmarks
- a page on celebrations
- extra pages of your choice
