This week we invited some visitors into our school to see the great work we have been doing over the last three years. We were delighted to have the opportunity to work with a current Ofsted Lead Inspector and two Barnet Headteachers. This was not an Ofsted Inspection but a review that the school asked for as part of our self-evaluation and identify what we are doing well and what we can continue to get even better with.

The team spent Thursday in school, observing the teaching and learning happening in classrooms and talking to different pupils about their learning and progress. They also spoke to different leaders about their roles, responsibilities and the impact of their leadership.

I am so proud to share with you that the initial feedback we have received has been very positive. The team highlighted many areas of strength. It was great to hear that the work we have doing on

developing our curriculum and the emphasis placed on reading is impactful and leading to good outcomes. It was inspiring to hear our children and staff could talk confidently and passionately about our ethos of being the best you can and working towards your Super North Star.

Areas to continue to further improve were the same ones as identified by the Senior Leaders showing our Self Evaluation is accurate.

I will share more details on the final report when we receive this. It is a lovely way to celebrate as we approach the end of the school year.

Sports Day

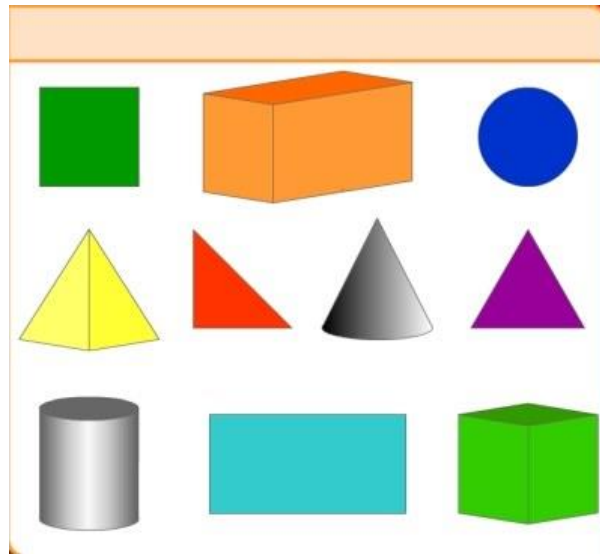

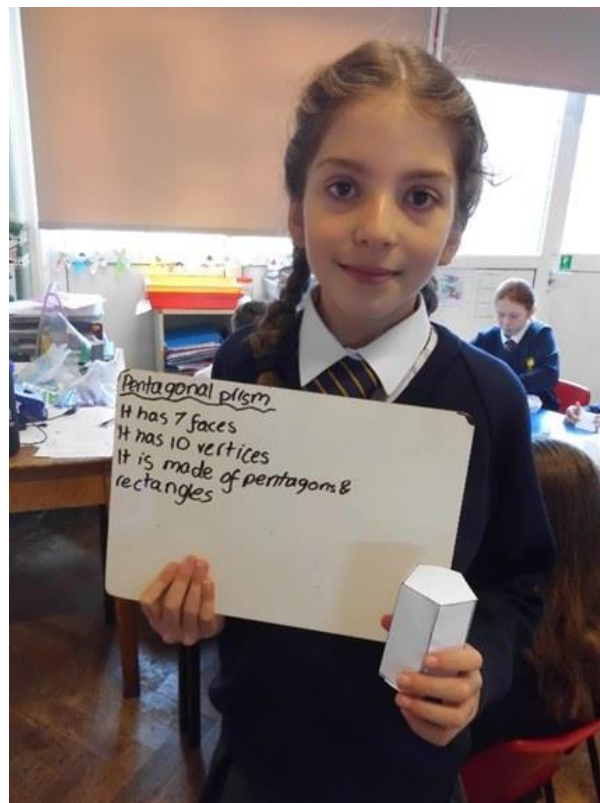
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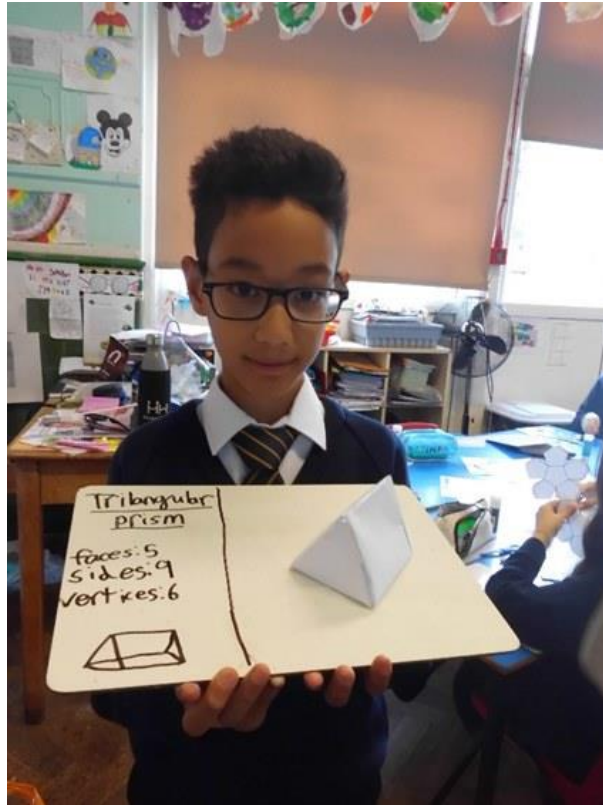
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Ambitious Me

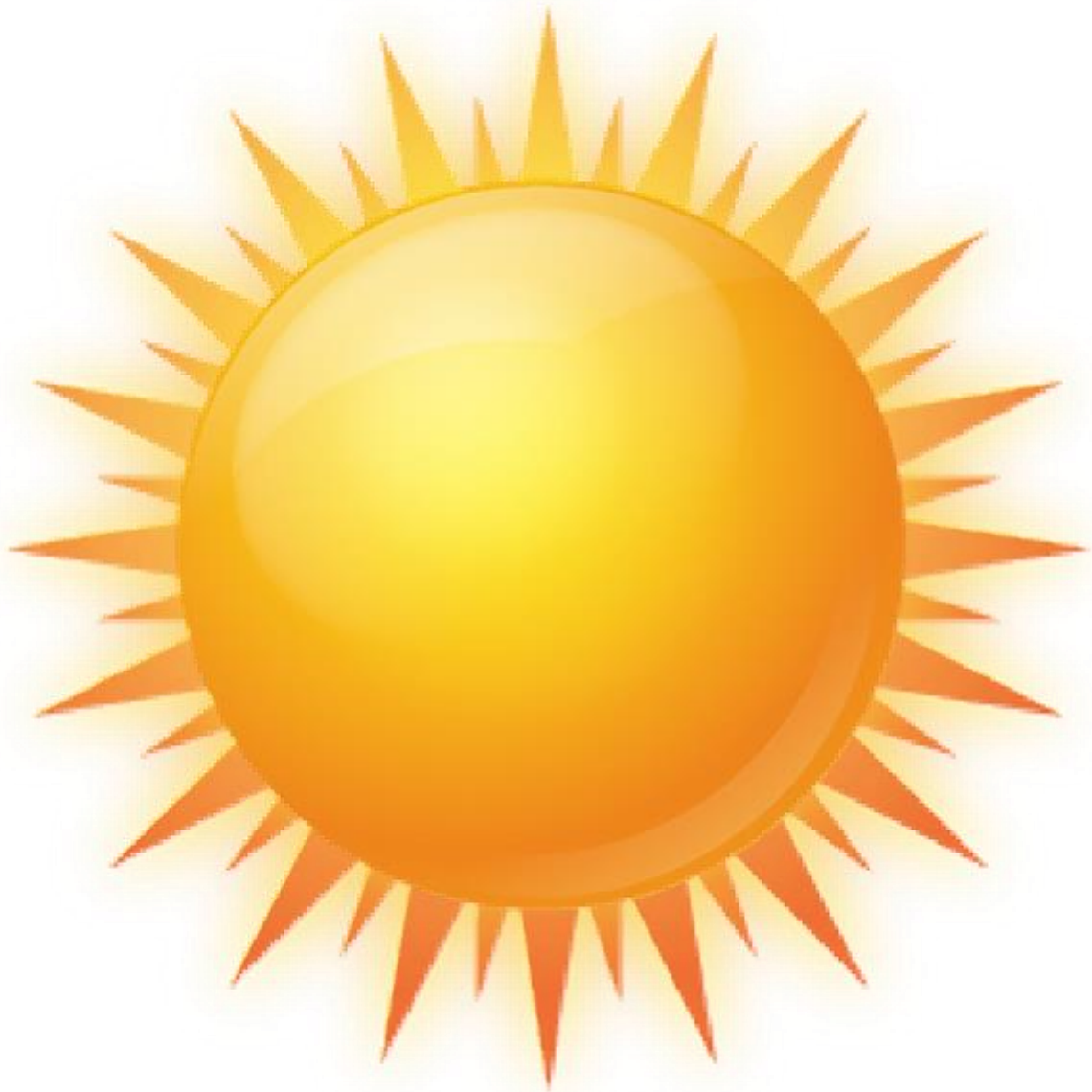

Spare Clothing

If your child has been given spare clothing from the school, please make sure it is returned to the school office, washed, dried and in a bag labelled spare clothing. We have handed out multiple trousers in the last few weeks and these have not been returned.

Appointments

Parents should endeavour to make doctor/dentist appointments out of school hours, however, if this is not possible a copy of an appointment card must be shown at the office.
